Note to Editors:

Azule Energy is a *joint venture that* brought together bp and Eni's business in Angola, officially launched on August 1, 2022. It has the highest equity oil and gas production in Angola and 2 billion barrels of liquid resources, with oil and gas production expected to increase to approximately 250,000 barrels per day (boe/d) over the next 5 years. Holds a stake in 16 licenses (of which, 6 are blocks in the research phase) and is part of Angola LNG JV. Azule Energy also took over Eni's stake in Solenova, a solar company jointly owned by Sonangol and the collaboration in the Luanda Refinery.
