The Oil and Gas Methane Partnership 2.0 ("OGMP 2.0") is the United Nations Environment Programme's (UNEP) flagship oil and gas reporting and mitigation programme. It is a multistakeholder Partnership between non-company members including UNEP, the European Commission, the Environmental Defence Fund, the Clean Air Task Force and over 115 international oil and gas companies aimed at improving the accuracy and transparency of methane emissions reporting, which is necessary for effective mitigation. The OGMP 2.0 supports companies to gather accurate methane emissions data to develop credible methane emissions mitigation plans and targets, prioritizing the most material sources of emissions.
